### Placement Drives





### Industrial/Field Visits/ Educational Tour

The Department of Biotechnology went on a 3-day trip to Chikmangalore, Coorg, and Bangalore from 01.02.2023 to 03.02.2023. They visited Coffee Plantation -Thippanahalli Estate, which is a coffee museum, an initiative by the Coffee Board of India and they learned the entire process of coffee processing. This museum depicts the history of coffee and various other processes including picking, grinding, and drying using which the bean was made. Instruments used in the making of coffee and other detailed processing along with a tasting of the final product was available which provided a detailed insight into coffee processing. They also visited biodiversity places like Mullayangiri, and Seethalangiri points, to witness some of the scenic biodiverse places and also to see the rare Kurinji plant which blooms once in 12 years. Students witnessed various flora and fauna that originated in those places. In Coorg, they visited the Dubarae forest and Nisargadhama Reserve Forests. Duabarae Reserve Forest is an elephant camp located in Coorg with the majestic and gigantic beauty of many elephants in their original habitat. Nisargadhama Reserve Forest is an island formed by the river Cauvery. It is a place filled with thick bamboo groves, sandalwood, teak trees, and a bird park where exotic and different kinds of birds could be seen. Finally, they visited Dextrose Technologies Pvt. Ltd where the Managing Director and Scientists delivered a lecture regarding instrumentation setup and their working process, various Ayurvedic sample testing, HPLC testing, extraction of samples using solvent, and also immune boosting products. This helped the students to gain knowledge in various fields and also paved the way to gain exposure to obtain job opportunities. The students had an overall great experience with lots of new product development and new venture setup ideas.
